Skill Week 2021 was successfully organized in the presence of dignitaries, diplomats, corporates and hundreds of youths from Nepal. The event succeeded in reaching more than 2000+ youth through workshops, sessions and competitions. ## GLOCAL AFTER ONLINE PROGRAMS

With the dedication to Building Online Learning Community, Glocal After School initiated Online events to engage people in skill development activities. Coming to this date GAS has successfully conducted over 70+ Live Online Courses; 6 Self-Paced Online Learning Courses along with Online Webinars & Competitions. Glocal After School has been providing various Corporate Training/ Courses along with skill enhancing courses for the students and professionals.

## a. Eduten Playground:

Glocal After School, collaborated with Eduten (#1 Digital Math Learning Platform. From Finland) to bring digital learning and teaching innovation called Finland Math to school students of Nepal. Finland Math includes Eduten Playground, a gamified and AI-based exercise platform that provides a scientifically proven improvement on learning results, teacher wellbeing, and student motivation. Eduten develops, manufactures and offers to customers a cloud-based software platform for educational purposes, associated with related professional services and documentation.

Glocal signed an agreement with Eduten with the vision of developing mathematical skills for the school students here in Nepal, and they will be able to learn Mathematics with much ease, due to its gamified AI technology. Intended to equip students with valuable learning opportunities that will support their success in the future, the course includes mandatory tips and techniques, to solve their curriculum.

## b. <u>Unschool:</u>

Unschool is the new, easy, and definitive path for keeping up with 21st century skills. It is the platform where learners can fit in a system crafted for the masses and learn in a unique way that brings out the best version of themselves. Glocal collaborated with Unschool, for bringing skillful self-learning courses on various themes like communication, IT, Business, Science & Technology, Life Skills and many more to the youths & professionals.

## c. <u>Capacity Building Training on Project Cycle Management (PCM) for PMEP</u> Employment Service Centers Staff Members

The Ministry of Labour, Employment and Social Security; Prime Minister Employment Program has successfully organized 6 hours of Capacity Building Training on Project Cycle Management (PCM) for 1506 local staff of 753 PMEP Employment Service Centers of Nepal. The training was implemented by Glocal After School, a venture of Glocal Pvt. Ltd in support of ILO.

The 10 days Capacity Building Training on Project Cycle Management (PCM) was conducted by providing training to 753-employment service centers local staff on basic principles of results-based management basics, and communication. Four dynamic trainers facilitated the

training who had the experience of leading multiple training programs and consulting services for project planning, mapping, and implementation.

Participants were introduced to Project Cycle Management Fundamentals, Tools and techniques for project design and management, monitoring and evaluation, Public employment programs, learning and experiences, Approach of Documentation, Reporting and communication and Effective services and delivery by employment services centers.

## d. Knowledge Maestro Competition:

Knowledge Maestro, an initiation of Glocal After School in association with Kings College and eSewa was organized on the 27<sup>th</sup> of November to make young people engaged in intellectual activities. The online competition was made available to every individual (16-24 years old) to participate through Glocal After School. The main motive behind organizing the competition was to help participants gain and utilize their knowledge, and also to encourage the exposure of youth and commend their efforts towards active learning and analyzing. Not just the knowledge, but the quiz competition was announced with 3 Winners who bagged the cash prize of Rs. 10000, Rs. 5000 and Rs. 2000 respectively.

## e. Movers Workshop:

Glocal successfully conducted 15 Movers Workshop this year. Movers Workshop is a 2-hours fun and interactive workshop that consists of a series of activities such as facilitated group and plenary discussions, self-reflection exercises and role-plays, that is being organized to Understand and empathize with the priorities of other youth from various backgrounds, relating it with the values of UNDP's core values and mission. It also highlighted the current and future priorities of youth in the Asia Pacific. Mover's Workshop was initiated by UNDP Youth Co: Lab in support of Intercultural Education (ICE) to develop a community of volunteers who can take action.

## f. CGIM presents Tech Camp- IT Solutions for Sustainable Tourism

CGIM presents "*Tech Camp- IT Solutions for Sustainable Tourism*" was conducted in collaboration with Glocal After School. Tech Camp - IT Solution for Sustainable Tourism was a 2- days free non-residential event being organized focusing on problem solving and quick-

thinking skills. This camp is especially for the young minds making them come together to UNDERSTAND- ANALYZE- CREATE sustainable solutions for Tourism with IT.

## g. GAS Monthly Quiz:

Skillful learning is the process by which learners examine and evaluate their feelings, experiences or beliefs about learning to cultivate and grow self-knowledge about how they learn best. In this modern world, skills are something that makes an individual unique, successful and a better person. The assessment gave real-time experience in evaluating their abilities by taking complimentary online quizzes. We organized 12 GAS Monthly Quiz.

## h. KWS presents Online Learning Fest 2021

KWS presents Online Learning Fest by Glocal After School, was an inter-school level SEE students engagements program to uplift student's enthusiasm, creativity and energy. It was conducted on 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2021 to 4<sup>th</sup> September, 2021. The event had several workshops, competitions & motivational sessions.

## i. World Youth Skills Day Celebration:

World Youth Skills Day 2021 was conducted on July 15, 2021 with the theme – "Celebrating the resilience and creativity of youth throughout the crisis." We had an 1-hour virtual youth dialogue where we had prominent speakers from different areas discussing the ever-increasing significance of youth skills as the world is embarking on a transition towards a sustainable model of development.

The virtual event highlighted the role of skills in youth, and the discussion will be on the same theme, about how we can enhance the creativity of youths. The event was led with a dialogue from different skillful personalities sharing their perspective.

## j. Online Courses:
