



This was the third edition of the Knowledge Maestro Online Quiz where participants were given two different categories i.e., Tourism & Hospitality and IT & Business. Ages between 16-24 were the participants of the quiz. This was a single-round quiz where the cash prize for the winner, 1st runner-up, and 2nd runner-up was 15,000, 10,000, and 5,000 respectively.

In the first round, a press conference and a call for applications were held. Following that, the physical activation was held in over **600+ schools** reaching **65,300+ teenagers** and providing information about Glocal Teen Hero. Glocal's 20under20 were chosen and the top six finalists were announced through social media. Those finalists were nurtured and trained in **Self Competency Workshop sessions**. On the last day of the event, one fantastic teen was awarded Wai Wai Glocal Teen Hero Nepal at the award ceremony, The Soaltee Kathmandu.

And, the winner was **Mr. Rahul Ranjan Sah**, an 18-year-old Astronomy Enthusiast from Dhanusha.

Mr. Sah is an Astropreneur, Astronomer, and Researcher. He is devoted to astronomical research. He is hardworking and passionate. He is associated with the Nepal Astronomical Society, Student Exploration and Development of Space-Nepal. He is also a founder member of Student Development and Exploration in Space - SXC. Currently, he is working as an Astropreneur in the project venture "Arohan " initiating to commercialize and develop Nepal's 1st private space mission. He has also dedicated himself completely to developing resources for students all over Nepal.

He is working lately to change the perception involving, initiating, and sustaining multiple fronts of Astronomy from Outreach to translations to research with NASA and representing Nepal. Founded 1st internationally affiliated high school club of Nepal, and 1st Aviation & Aerospace based organization venture within SEDS-Nepal and SEDS-US.

Represented Nepal among 20+ countries and showcased Nepali governmental institutions, and excelling in the venture of Space travel where the team worked out the best and cheapest costing around NRS 30000 compared to NRS 100000 to launch Sano Satellites.

Glocal Teen Hero India 2022

Glocal Teen Hero has extended beyond the borders of Nepal organizing Glocal Teen Hero India to appreciate, recognize and encourage teenagers across South Asia. Achievements of teenagers beyond academics were acknowledged by the platform. This year marked the third iteration of Glocal Teen Hero India. The announcement of The Top 6 finalists of Glocal Teen Hero India, 2022 was done on December 3, 2022 and one fantastic teen was awarded as Glocal Teen Hero India at the final event. The award ceremony of Glocal Teen Hero India 2022 was conducted physically this year at The University of Delhi, New Delhi on December 23, 2022. **Mr. Rudhvik Dharamkar** 18 years old Social Entrepreneur from Telangana won the title of Glocal Teen Hero India 2022.

Mr. Dharamkar is a social student entrepreneur who is confident, creative, determined, independent, knowledge-seeking, relationship-building, and risk-taking person. He is a Founder & CEO at Fleckor Media LLP. He worked as a tech content creator on Techy Rudvik YouTube page to educate people on tech products & mobile software applications. The content creation helped him to get his first internship at a news media organization Ground News which focused on developing his skill set. He also developed a campus studio facility for college-going students.

He and his team have helped 2 NGOs namely Mustafa Foundation & Aliya Humanitarian Foundation have been associated with Fleckor where he is helping them go digital. He is also appreciated by the IT Minister of Telangana state for his vision with Fleckor at T-Hub for EO GSEA Regional Finals Hyderabad. He also got Featured in a few articles & Video Interviews like Global Alliance For Mass Entrepreneurship, The Entrepreneurs of India, The Wakeup Telanagana (page 2), and many more.

Glocal Teen Hero Sri Lanka 2022

We got a substantial number of applications i.e. **236** this year from all throughout Sri Lanka. On November 30, 2022, the finalists for Glocal Teen Hero Sri Lanka 2022 were unveiled. All the top finalists were interviewed by our juries based on the initiation, vision, sustainability, impact. Then, one fantastic teen was awarded Glocal Teen Hero Sri Lanka 2022 at the final award ceremony of Glocal Teen Hero Sri Lanka 2022 held at The Taj Samudra, Colombo on December 15, 2022. **Mr. Risanga Dinsara Bandara Abeygunasekara**, 17 years old Activist won the title of Glocal Teen Hero Sri Lanka 2022.

Mr. Abeygunasekara is an entrepreneur, an innovator, an artist, an activist, a problem solver, and an influencer. He is interested in social work and cinematography to bring those two together to build a more impactful industry in entertaining as well as serving the community.

The project he works on is tutoring 6th to 7th-grade students to improve their English Language skills in a rural school, and rather than using traditional ways in a normal classroom to teach, he uses experimental activities to improve themselves individually and as a group.

Another project is to bring awareness about the basics of sustainable life and how to use them in practical life, for example- paper recycling. Another project he is working on is to increase the quality of life of differently-abled youth in the Batik industry, he is planning to send the Batik products created by them to other countries. He has already worked with a vocational training institute to make this happen.

He designed a program to increase awareness about disability in a community where he has brought together about 50+ differently-abled youth and people from different professions to learn through observation, interaction, and empathy. He also build a team from countries representing India, Egypt, Sri Lanka, and Germany, and was the project head where he and the team designed a device for deaf-blind people to access quality education and communication.

Glocal Teen Hero Bangladesh 2022

On December 1, 2022, the finalists for Glocal Teen Hero Bangladesh 2022 were unveiled. All the top finalists were interviewed by our juries based on the initiation, vision, sustainability, impact. Then, one fantastic teen was awarded Glocal Teen Hero Bangladesh 2022 at the final award ceremony of Glocal Teen Hero Bangladesh 2022 held at Daffodil International University, Dhanmondi on December 20, 2022. **Mr. Talha Zubair 18 years old** Science Enthusiast from Chandpur won the title of first Glocal Teen Hero Bangladesh 2022.

Mr. Zubair is very much passionate about molecular biology, biotech startups, sustainable agriculture, and emerging technologies. He is a Science Enthusiast who was awarded a Bronze Medalist in the Life Sciences category and became a medalist in the competition for the first from Bangladesh. He founded 'Bacto Crop', an AgriTech startup to accelerate sustainable

agriculture using beneficial soil microbiomes. His microorganism and plant-based research projects at Bacto Crop are showing an enormous possibility of sustainable agriculture with eco-friendly, effective agro-products ensuring crop safety and faster germination. He won multiple international business and innovation competitions by representing Bacto Crop including becoming a finalist in the paradigm challenge, a finalist at the Gifted and Talented Silicon Valley Innovators Venture Challenge, and a bronze awardee in the Duke of Edinburgh Award.

He has also become a global champion in cities in space competitions and an international 3rd prize winner in the NSS Space settlement contest. Recently, he became a silver medalist as a Bangladeshi team member at the International Medicine and Disease Olympiad 2022.




GLOCAL TEEN HERO OVERALL ENGAGEMENT

Financial Literacy Training for Women

Glocal Pvt. Ltd. in partnership with the Embassy of Lithuania, New Delhi organized the Financial Training program for women in Lahan, Janakpur & Bardibas city of Madhesh Province with the objective of promoting financial education and the development of financial literacy knowledge and skills of women. Student Exchange Program

Ltd in coordination with Kathmandu World School and hosted by Rishihood University, India as Exchange Partner conducted “Learn Life Skills” – Student Exchange Program for high school students of Nepal. MAHAKUMBHA:

Glocal partnered with Debate Network Nepal (DNN) as a supporting partner for MahaKumbha 2022 which was the 9th edition of the National Schools Debating Championship aiming to provide a platform for young debaters to participate in debates using the World Schools Debating Championship (WSDC) format. The championship started from 25th November to 28th November and the selected Nepali Teams would participate in WSDC 2023 to be held in Hanoi, Vietnam during late July 2023.
